introduce short a, i, and o, read short a, i, and o words in context, and write short a, i, and o words.

Language Arts and Handwriting, -We will read and write High Frequency Words, work on our comprehension skills, using the 5 figure Retell Hand, simple sentences, verbs and adjectives, sort nouns and verbs, We are slowly getting familiar to the Daily 5, we are working on building our stamina, learning to read to self for 5 minutes. In HANDWRITING we will practice our letter formation for the following letters, J,W, D, K, R, L, H.

Social Studies and Science-This month we will learn about Christopher Columbus, different kinds of leaves, bats, and pumpkins
